BIOGRAPHY:

Kwong-Liem Karl Kwan, PhD is an Associate Professor in the Department of Educational, School, and Counseling Psychology at the University of Missouri at Columbia. He earned his PhD (Counseling Psychology) at the University of Nebraska at Lincoln. Prior to pursuing his psychology studies in the U.S., he worked as a research interviewer in the Department of Psychiatry at the Chinese University of Hong Kong investigating the psychiatric epidemiology among community populations in Hong Kong. Dr. Kwan's research and clinical interests focus on assessment of Asians, Asian Americans, and immigrants in the U.S. He serves on the editorial boards of the Journal of Counseling Psychology, Asian Journal of Counselling, and as editor of the International Forum of The Counseling Psychologist. Dr. Kwan is a proud member of the Asian American Psychological Association (AAPA). He was a past program co-chair and conference co-chair of AAPA's annual conferences, and he continues to serve as a mentor to student members.
