WHAT IS IPS? –

THE INDIVIDUAL PLACEMENT AND SUPPORT MODEL (IPS) PLACES EMPHASIS ON
COMPETITIVE EMPLOYMENT (OF THE CLIENT’S CHOICE). A KEY COMPONENT OF IPS IS
THAT THE CLIENT WHO WANTS TO FIND WORK IS PLACED DIRECTLY INTO A WORK
SITUATION OF THEIR CHOICE WITHOUT PRIOR TRAINING, BUT RECEIVES ONGOING
SUPPORT TO HELP THEM RETAIN THEIR JOB.

WHO IS LUANA TURNER? –

LUANA R. TURNER, PSY.D., IS A PSYCHOLOGIST AT THE UCLA AFTERCARE RESEARCH
PROGRAM, A CLINICAL RESEARCH PROGRAM FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH SCHIZOPHRENIA AT THE
UCLA SEMEL INSTITUTE OF NEUROSCIENCE AND HUMAN BEHAVIOR. DR. TURNER PROVIDES
THERAPY AND CASE MANAGEMENT, SUPERVISES SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT AND SUPPORTED
EDUCATION INTERVENTIONS, AND IS A CLINICAL RESEARCHER AT THE UCLA AFTERCARE
RESEARCH PROGRAM. DR. TURNER CONDUCTS RECRUITMENT AND DIAGNOSTIC
EVALUATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS IN THE CENTER FOR NEUROCOGNITION AND EMOTION IN
SCHIZOPHRENIA AND THE UCLA AFTERCARE RESEARCH PROGRAM.

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
