**About the Workshop:** Please join us for this dynamic training presented by Richmond Area Multi-Services, Inc. (RAMS), in partnership with the San Francisco Department of Public Health Behavioral Health Services (BHS), to learn about Community Advisory Boards (also referred to as Consumer Advisory Boards or Councils). These groups serve as opportunities to provide input to agencies and organizations to best meet the needs of individuals in the community and ensure consumer voice is valued and incorporated across all levels of program planning and service provision within the system of care in San Francisco.

Presenters from within Behavioral Health Services, peer representatives with experience being members of CABs and other advocacy and advisory groups, and speakers from community-based organizations will take part in training and leading discussion throughout the workshop. Participants will be given an overview of the purpose of Community Advisory Boards, review CAB member roles and responsibilities, and examine a case study in which a behavioral health services program was generated from and with significant community input. Participants will also hear from and engage in dialogue with a panel of peer representatives who have served on advisory groups/councils, and witness the powerful impact consumer voice can have as a force to propel high quality, person-centered resources and supports throughout our community.
