Where to set a boundary when providing counseling and supportive services is often a complex question. In this workshop we will explore the basics of setting boundaries, various types and traits of boundaries, and examples of what it means to cross or violate a boundary. Participants will even have the chance to discuss boundaries as they relate to the topic of social justice issues and changes in policy that may affect our community. As with any complicated concept, dialogue and hands-on practice lead to the most meaningful learning.
